# About this Report

This report provides an overview of service activity and performance across a number of key metrics for **June 2026**.

In January 2026, Tusla commenced implementation of a major reform programme aimed at improving services delivered to children, young people and their families.

Previously, Tusla was set up to work across 17 geographical areas configured into six regions. These areas differed in size and staffing levels with the result that children, young people and families, did not always have the same level of access to services, or the same level of supports available.

To address this inequity, Tusla changed its structure to work across 30 networks in six regions. Each new network was indexed using Central Statistics Office demographic data, including population size, disadvantage and deprivation. The networks are more equal in size and staffing ensuring more equal access to services for everyone, no matter where they live.

This new configuration can be viewed on the map and table in Appendix 1 of this report.

The key metrics included in this report provide a snapshot of performance and activity across the following service areas, Safety & Welfare (previously referred to as Child Protection and Welfare), Children in Care, Tusla Education Support Services (Tess) and Children's Services Regulation (CSR). National and regional breakdowns of the data are provided in the main body of the report. Network level data can be found in Appendix 3.

**Data can change from previously published data due to ongoing validation of data. Also, data for 2026 should be interpreted with caution due to work underway to align cases to new regions/networks.**

# Key Messages

## SAFETY AND WELFARE

### Referrals

- 9,456 referrals in June 2026, bringing to 56,259 the number of referrals for the first six months of 2026 (*data provisional*)
- 7% (3,630) increase in referrals YTD versus the same period in 2025 (52,629).

### Open Cases (Safety & Welfare and Children in Care (mainstream) Combined)

- 24,735 cases open to social work (includes safety & welfare cases and children in care) at the end of June 2026; 49 (<1%) fewer than May 2026 (24,784).
- 5% (1,280) increase in open cases year on year
- 80% (19,804) of cases allocated to a case worker.
- 77% (15,183) of allocations to social workers and 23% (4,621) to other professionals.
- 4,931 (20%) cases awaiting allocation, 377 (7%) fewer than May 2026 (5,308).

### Open Cases (Safety & Welfare Cases Only)

- 18,885 cases open to social work (safety & welfare cases only) at the end of June 2026; 75 (<1%) fewer than May 2026 (18,960).
- 6% (1,129) increase in open cases year on year.
- 75% (14,131) of cases allocated to a case worker.
- 71% (10,088) of allocations to social workers and 29% (4,043) to other professionals.
- 4,754 (25%) cases awaiting allocation, 391 (8%) fewer than May 2026 (5,145).

### Child Protection Notification System (CPNS)

- 1,251 children 'active' on the CPNS at the end of June 2026, 33 (3%) more than May 2026 (1,218), second consecutive monthly increase.
- 23% (235) increase in the number 'active' year on year
- 97% (1,216) of children allocated to a social worker; 35 children awaiting allocation, 7 (25%) more than May 2026 (28).
- 13 of the 35 children awaiting allocation were allocated to another professional worker; 28 of the 35 children were subsequently allocated to a social worker.

### Child Abuse Substantiation Procedure (CASP)

- 121 referrals assigned in the first six months of 2026
- 293 assessments open under CASP at the end of June 2026; 36% (167) decrease year on year

- 92% (270) of open assessments allocated to a social worker, 23 (8%) assessments awaiting allocation, 24 (51%) fewer than May 2026 (47).

## **CHILDREN IN CARE**

- 5,983 children in care (includes 133 unaccompanied minors) at the end of June 2026, a 3% (176) increase year on year.
- 84.8% of all children in care (mainstream and unaccompanied minors) are in foster care; 86.4% of mainstream children in care in foster care.
- 1,177 (19.7%) children in care are in placements with private providers, 12 (1%) fewer than May 2026 (1,165)
- 9% (100) increase in placements with private providers year on year.
- 97% (5,803) of children in care were allocated to a case worker.
- 90% (5,225) of allocations were to social workers and 10% (578) were to other professionals.
- 180 (3%) children awaiting allocation, 15 (9%) more than May 2026 (165)
- 84% (5,053) of children in care have an up-to-date care plan.

## **TUSLA EDUCATION SUPPORT SERVICES**

- 13,133 referrals for an educational welfare service this school year to date.
- 10,614 cases open to educational welfare services at the end of June 2026, 1,111 (9%) fewer than May 2026 (11,725) when the highest number for all months this school YTD was reported.
- 55.5% (5,894) of cases allocated to educational welfare officers, 4,720 (44.5%) cases on a waiting list for allocation, 930 (16%) fewer than May 2026 (5,650).

## **CHILDREN'S SERVICES REGULATION**

### **Early Years Services (Pre-Schools)**

- 3,913 pre-school services on the register at the end of June 2026; <1% (28) decrease in the number of the register year on year.
- 1,374 inspections of pre-school services in the first six months of 2026; 6% (77) increase in inspections year-on-year.

### **Home Education**

- 2,674 children on the register for home education at the end of June 2026; 7% (172) increase in the number on the register year on year.
- 345 children awaiting assessment for registration at the end of June 2026, 6 (2%) more than May 2026 (339)
- 11% (33) increase in the number of children awaiting assessment for registration year-on-year.

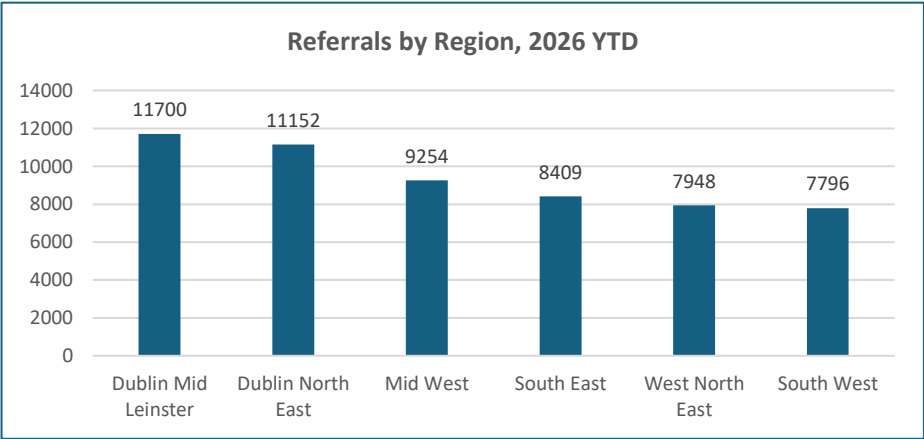
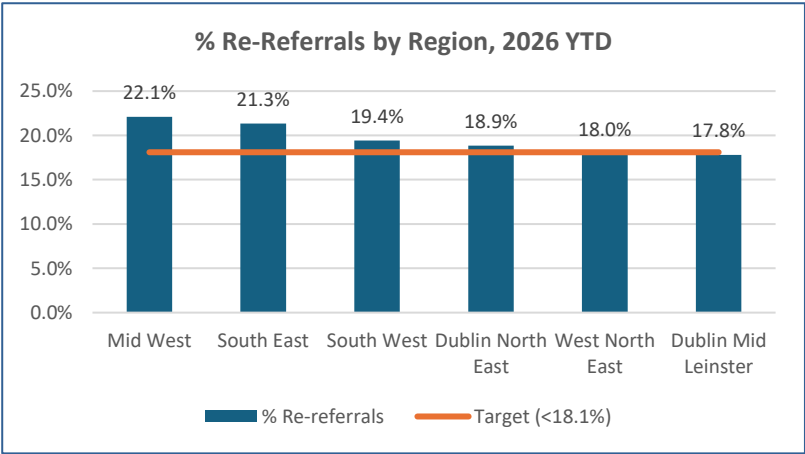
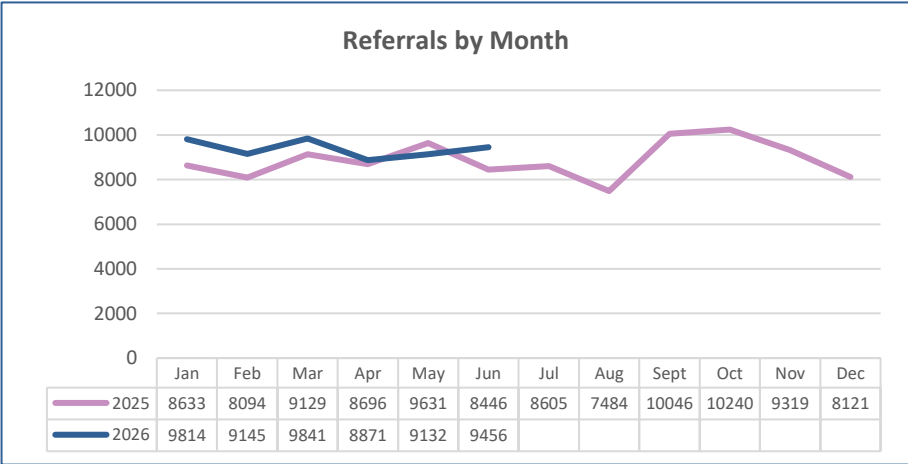

- 7% (3,630) increase in referrals year on year
- 19.5% of referrals YTD were re-referrals against a target of ≤18.1%

### Regions

- Highest number of referrals YTD reported by Dublin Mid Leinster (11,700; 21%), fewest number South West (7,796; 14%).
- Highest rate of re-referrals reported by Midwest (22.1%), lowest rate Dublin Mid Leinster (17.8%).

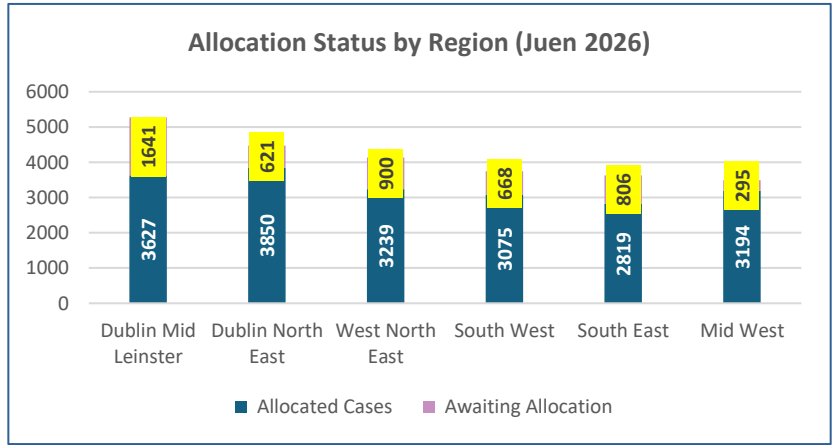
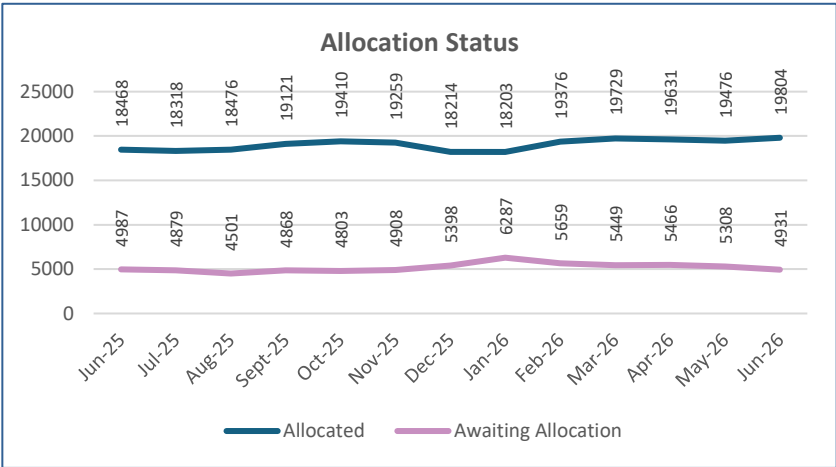
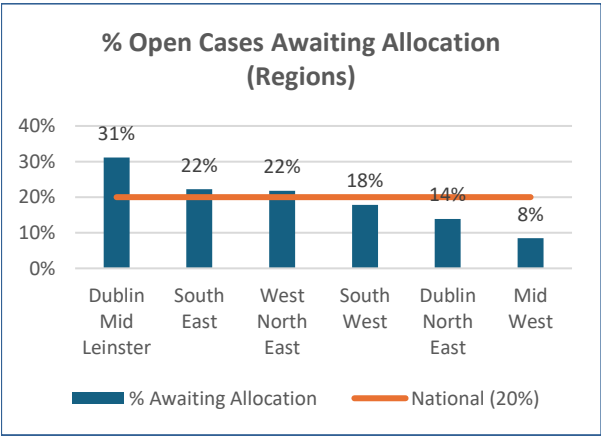

- **24,735 cases open** to social work at the end of June 2026; 49 (<1%) fewer than May 2026 (24,784)
- 5% (1,280) increase in open cases year on year
- **80% (19,804) of open cases allocated to a case worker**
- **4,931 (20%) cases awaiting allocation**, 377 (7%) fewer than May 2026 (5,308)
- 77% (15,183) of allocations are to social workers; 23% (4,621) to other professionals
- **263 (5%) cases awaiting allocation are high priority**, 11 (4%) fewer than May 2026 (274).

#### Regional

- **Dublin Mid Leinster - highest number of open cases**, (5,268; 21%).
- **Mid West - fewest number** (3,489; 14%).

### National

- **1,251 children 'active' on the CPNS**, 33 (3%) more than May 2026 (1,218)
- 23% (235) increase in the number of children 'active' on the CPNS year-on-year.
- **97% (1,216) of children allocated to a social worker**; 35 children awaiting allocation, 7 (25%) more than May 2026 (28).
- 13 of the 35 children awaiting allocation were allocated to another professional worker; 28 of the 35 children were subsequently allocated to a social worker.
- **112 (9%) children 'active' for more than 18 months**, 3 fewer than May 2026 (115) and 38 (51%) more than June 2025 (74).

### Regional

- **Dublin Mid Leinster - highest number** (328; 26%) of children 'active'.
- **South East - fewest number** (94; 8%).
- Of the 35 children awaiting allocation, highest numbers reported by South East (10) and Dublin Mid Leinster (8).
- All children allocated in South West.

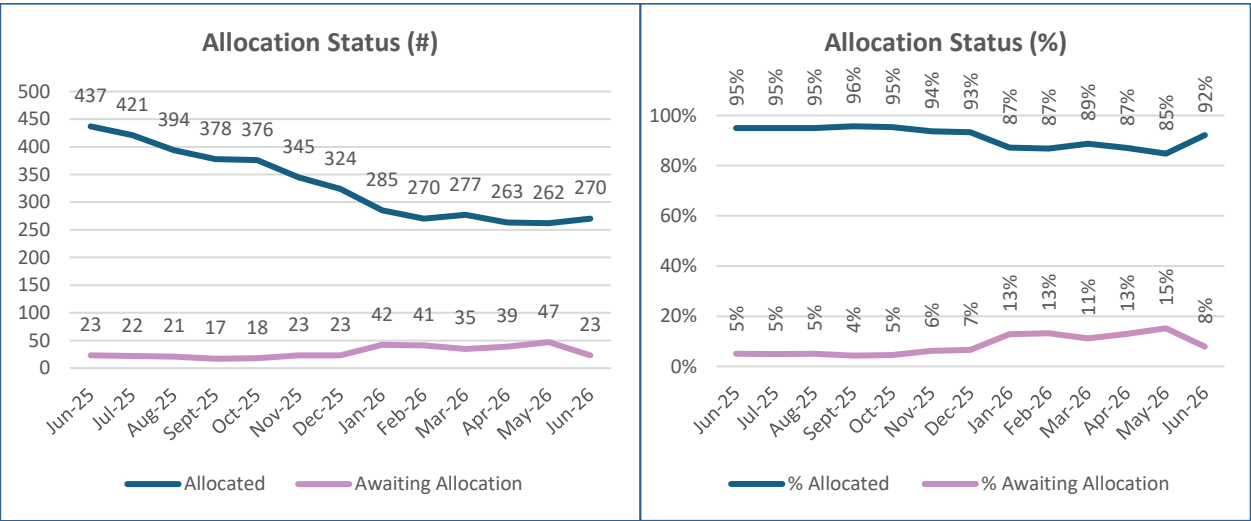
#### National

- **121 referrals assigned\*** in the first six months of 2026
- **293 assessments open** at the end of June 2026.
- **36% (167)** decrease in assessments open year on year
- **92% (270)** of assessments allocated to a social worker
- **23 (8%) assessments awaiting allocation**, 24 (51%) fewer than May 2026 (47) and the fewest number since December 2025 (23).

#### Regional

- **West North East - highest number** (93; 32%) of open assessments. **Dublin Mid Leinster - fewest number** (20; 7%).
- Fewer than 10 assessments awaiting allocation in all regions.

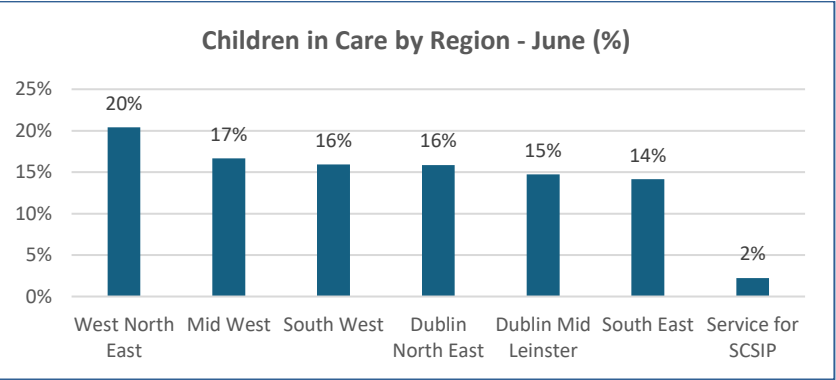
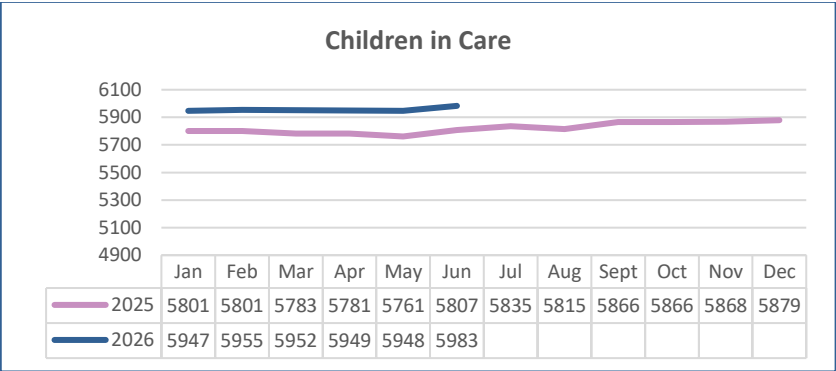
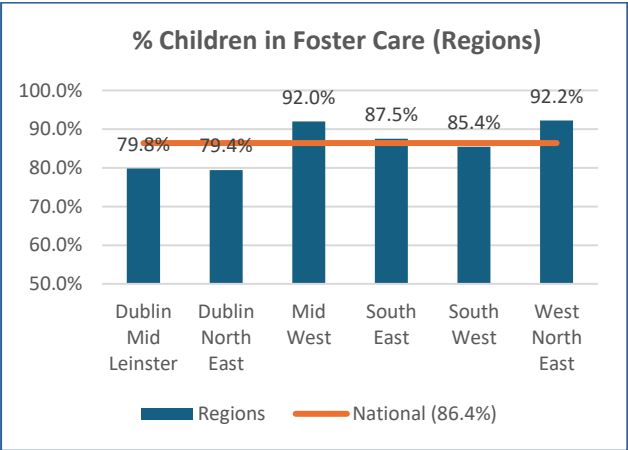
## Key Messages | June 2026

### National

- 5,983 children in care, includes 133 unaccompanied minors. The Service for Separated Children Seeking International Protection (SCSIP) reports an additional 346 children being accommodated / provided with services under Section 5 Child Care Act 1991.
- 3% (176) increase in children in care year on year (5,807).
- 84.8% of all children (mainstream and unaccompanied minors) in care are in foster care
- 86.4% of mainstream children in care in foster care

### Regional

- West North East - highest number of children in care (1,222; 20%).
- South East - fewest number in care (847; 14%).
- The percentage of children in foster care across the regions ranges from 92.2% in West North East to 79.4% in Dublin North East.
- 3 regions reporting a percentage lower than the national average of 86.4%

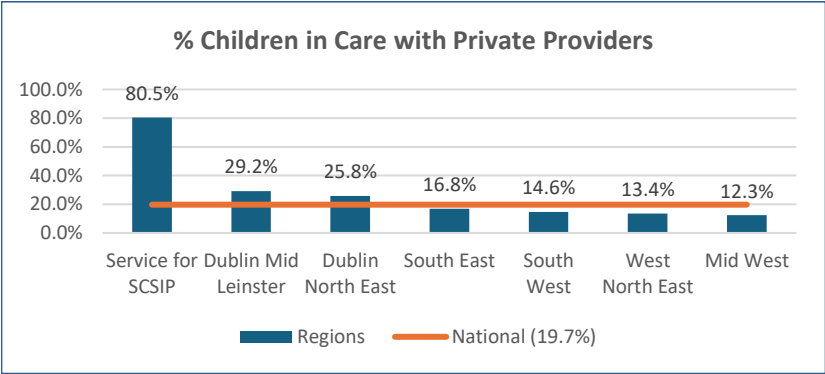
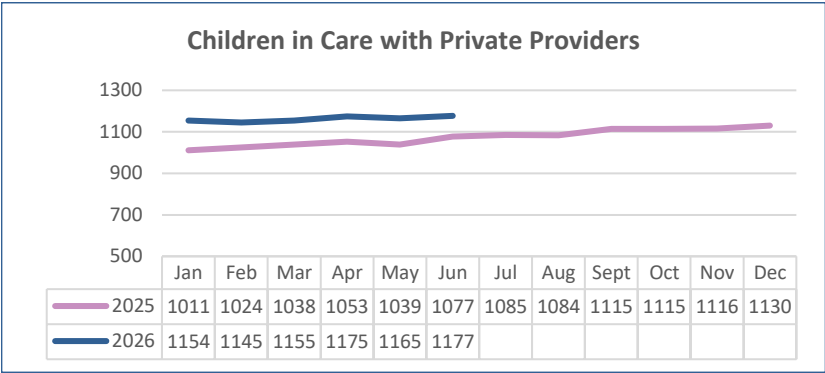
- **1,177 (19.7%) children** in care are with **private providers**, 12 (1%) more than May 2026 (1,165).
- **9% (100) increase** in the number of children with private providers year on year
- 36% (425) of children with private providers were in residential care, 54% (637) were in foster care and 10% (115) were in other care placements.

Regions

- Dublin Mid Leinster (257) and Dublin North (245) - highest numbers of children with private providers. Mid West reports the fewest number at 123.
- The percentage of children in care with private providers across the regions ranges from 29.2% (Dublin Mid Leinster) to 12.3% (Mid West) against a national average of 19.7%.

Service for Separated Children Seeking International Protection

- The majority of unaccompanied minors in care are with private providers (80.5%; 107).

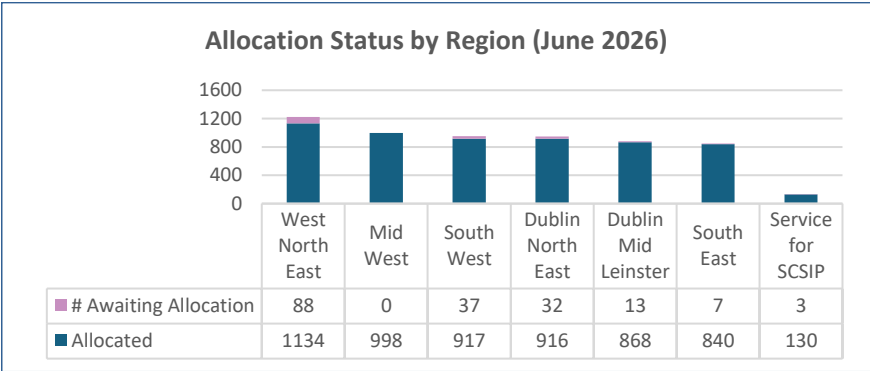
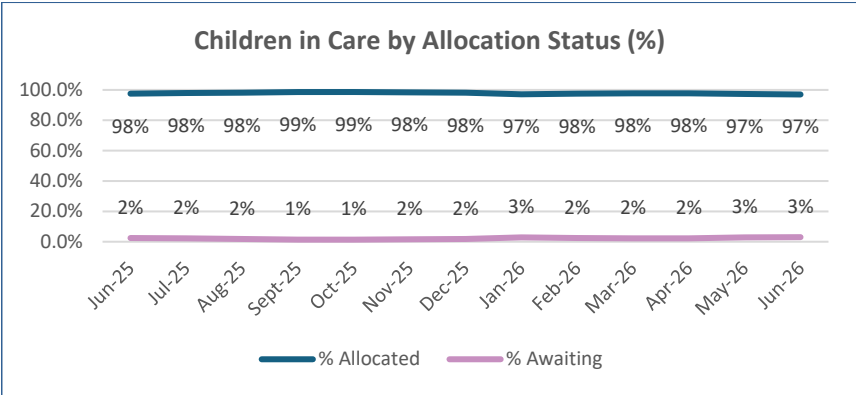

### National

- 97% (5,803) of children in care have an allocated case worker
- High rate consistently maintained
- 180 children awaiting allocation, 15 (9%) more than May 2026 (165).
- 90% (5,225) of allocations to social workers; 10% (578) to other professionals.
- 84% (5,053) children in care have an up-to-date care plan, 930 (16%) children awaiting, 79 (8%) fewer than May 2026 (1,009).

### Regions

- Five of the six regions reported more than 95% of children with an allocated worker with one region (Mid West) reporting 100%.
- Highest number of children awaiting allocation reported by West North East (88).
- Four of the six regions report at least 84% (national average) of children with an up-to-date care plan.
- Rates reported by Dublin Mid Leinster (81%) and Dublin North East (78%) slightly lower than average.

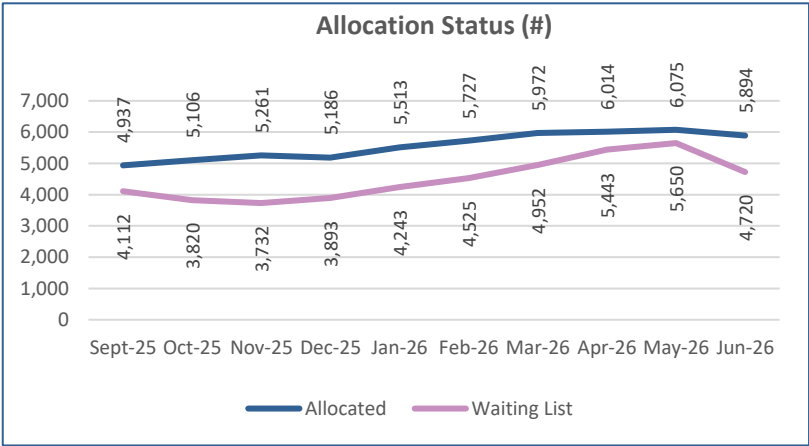
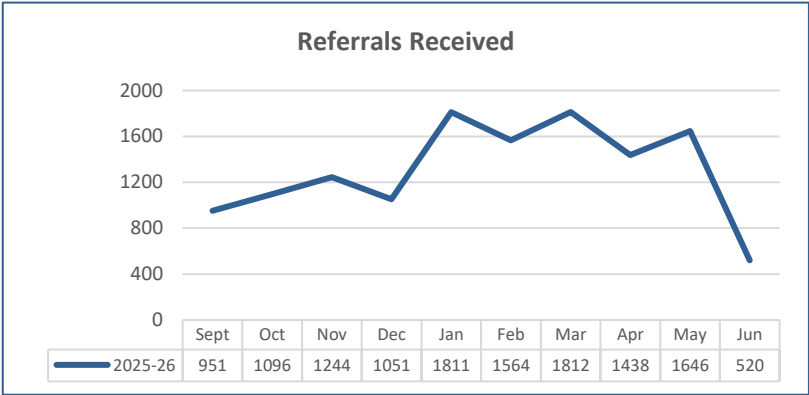
