

## **National School Attendance Campaign Poster Competition**

The National School Attendance Poster Competition is aimed at getting behind schools, pupils, parents/guardians and communities to raise awareness about the importance of regular school attendance.

The focus of the competition is for schools to raise awareness of attendance through discussion in classes, student council engagement, focus groups, parental participation, inter class competitions, displays and celebrations of students' poster designs.

The competition is open to all primary and post-primary schools. Each school can submit two poster designs, one junior entry and one senior entry. Special schools that have primary and post-primary pupils may submit four entries. For more information on this and how to submit an entry please refer to the 'How to Enter' section.

The closing date for entry is Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024. Please submit a photograph (saved as a jpeg file) or scan of the completed poster designs and the completed application form via email with the email subject line filled in as follows: School Name, Primary/Post-Primary/Special School, Roll Number and County e.g., email subject: St Annes, Primary, 12345R, Cork. Please note, entries will not progress to the judging stage without a fully completed application form.

All applications received will be acknowledged, and a digital badge will be supplied for your school.
