Re: COVID-19 Notification - Early Years Services

Dear Provider,

I hope you are keeping well. I am writing to remind you that as a registered provider you are legally required to notify the Early Years Inspectorate within three working days of becoming aware of a notifiable incident. The circumstances that require notification to Tusla are defined in legislation and the details are provided in the attached link.

At this time given the prevalence of COVID-19 in the community it is important to further clarify that COVID-19 notifications are required when

- 1. there is a diagnosis of a pre-school child attending the service, an employee, unpaid worker, contractor or other person working in the service.
- 2. if there are multiple cases present in your service one notification is sufficient and include details of associated cases on the form.
- 3. notifications are site specific.
